- · Income eligible
- Are willing to improve your job skill and learn new ones
- Reside in Favette, Tipton or Shelby Counties
- · Currently unemployed

- Receive interviewing and job search assistance
- Obtain computer and vocational training to update and build new skills
- Earn while you learn training at a local community agency
- Gain access to employers who want to hire experienced staff
- Resume writing
- Job counseling
